



Scholarship Application Requirements:

- Applicant shall furnish by February 1st of their graduation year:
 - A personal and family resume. The student must reside in Colorado.
 - A photograph (Non-Mandatory).
 - A certified copy of grade transcript and SAT or ACT scores.
 - Two letters of recommendation from one of the following sources:
 - Teacher
 - Community member
 - Civic leader
 - A religious leader in your home community
 - A statement of career goal or letter of intent
 - A statement or signature of an officer of the branch in which the parent or grandparent claims eligibility verifying that a parent or grandparent is a member of good standing of the COSALC.
 - Community service is a must!
 - A letter verifying the service is required.

Applicants for the student scholarship must be high school seniors. The COSALC invites the award winners the opportunity to share their personal story with the membership at the Colorado State Convention. Please keep the presentation to 3 – 5 minutes.
